

- end-stage kidney disease


Through this partnership we can share no-cost benefits for eligible patients. These benefits may improve patient outcomes, right when they are in the vulnerable acute setting.

We are introducing two additional Priority Attributions, designed to empower case managers and foster better communication between healthcare professionals and their patients.


